Corporations such as JP Morgan, Deloitte, HDFC Bank, Vodafone, Times of India Group and more partner with YUVA Unstoppable. YUVA Unstoppable's role is mainly in strategizing, coordinating, training, availing government permissions and monitoring of the CSR activities of partner companies. YUVA Unstoppable facilitates activities such as organizing sports day, drawing & craft competitions, for underprivileged children. Establishing libraries in municipal schools, getting the slum schools painted, providing scholarships to deserving kids, building safe water and sanitation facilities in these slum schools are a few additional examples of the activities facilitated by YUVA Unstoppable. Corporate partner employees come together to teach English and Maths 2 hours a week for 3 months to 6th and 7th grade kids in municipal schools once a year. Municipal kids are brought to corporations to visit, meet CEOs, see & understand the environment of company.

- 4) Training the YUVA Changemakers (on-field executioners) of the school unstoppable initiative for effective planning and execution of the activities.
- 5) Participating on-field activities of school unstoppable and help in effective knowledge management of these activities.
